- Two concrete cores have reached their maximum height, the tallest now standing at 32m. Core 1 at University Avenue will continue up to 30m.
- The steel frame is underway with over 1500 pieces of steel to be erected.
- L&TH received a second visit from the Considerate Constructors Scheme in September scoring 41/50, rated “Excellent”

Western Campus

- Soft strip and demolition works continue within the Western Campus.
- The Research Hub project will commence in the coming weeks with 477 rotary-bored piles to be installed.
