



Gàidhlig | Gaelic

Tha àrainneachd Ghàidhlig làidir againn ann an Ceiltis is Gàidhlig. Tha an togalach againn (3 Gàrraidhean an Oilthigh) na àite dà-chànanach far a bheil a' mhòr-chuid den luchd-obrach a' cleachdadadh Gàidhlig mar phrìomh chànan-obrach. Bidh iad an-còmhnaidh deònach Gàidhlig a bhruidhinn riut.

A bharrachd air na cùrsaichean againn, tha **UoG Gàidhlig** na iomairt tarsainn an Oilthigh air fad a chuireas gu mòr ris an àrainneachd Ghàidhlig seo. Tha e a' toirt cothrom do dh'oileanaich dol an sàs ann an iomadh tachartas Gàidhlig taobh a-muigh chlasaichean.

We have a strongly Gaelic environment in Celtic and Gaelic. Our building (3 University Gardens) is a bilingual space, with most staff using the language as their main working language and always happy to speak Gaelic to you.

In addition, the **UoG Gàidhlig** campus-wide initiative coordinated by the University's Gaelic officer Fiona Dunn, enhances students' and staff's Gaelic experience, offering many opportunities for Gaelic social activity outside class.

Tha sinn a' taigse trì cùrsaichean eadar-dhealaichte aig lre 1.

We offer three separate Gaelic courses at Level 1.

Gaelic 1 (Beginners)

For students with no knowledge of Gaelic or who have only studied it at elementary level.

Semester 1 focuses on core **grammar** and key **vocabulary**, with repeated **practice** through games, online exercises, and conversation in small groups.

In Semester 2, along with grammar and oral practice, a wider range of **reading** is introduced.

In Semester 2, also, all Level 1 Gaelic students attend one lecture a week on the Gaelic world from earliest times to the present day: 'Saoghal nan Gàidheal: Gaelic Society and Culture through the ages'.

Classes: 4 hours then 5 hours per week.

Assessment: regular language exercises; 3 written tests, 1 oral test; a final written exam and a final oral exam.


Gaelic 1 (Intermediate | Eadar-Mheadhanach)

For students with good Gaelic language skills, e.g. a Scottish Higher Gaelic (Learners)

In each semester you develop your language skills in **Sgilean Càinain** classes, reinforcing vocabulary, grammatical constructions, and idioms, and developing your oral language skills through small group discussion and presentations.

Language skills are reinforced in Semester 1 by reading contemporary **fiction**, e.g. the mystery novel *An Creanaiche* (The Fall Guy) by Mairi NicEachairne & Ruaraidh MacIlleathain; and in Semester 2 by studying a range of 20th century/contemporary **poems and songs** on major themes.

In Semester 2, also, all Level 1 Gaelic students attend one lecture a week on the Gaelic world from earliest times to the present day: 'Saoghal nan Gàidheal: Gaelic Society and Culture through the ages'.



Classes: 4 hours then 5 hours per week.

Assessment: Fortnightly language exercises; 1 book review and 1 essay in Gaelic; 1 written test; a final written exam and a final oral exam.

Teaching method: bilingual, increasingly in Gaelic as the year goes on. Bidh sinn a' dol eadar Beurla agus Gàidhlig, ach le barrachd is barrachd Gàidhlig tron bhliadhna.

Gàidhlig 1 (Adhartach)

Do dh'oileanaich a tha fileanta sa Ghàidhlig (m.e. aig a bheil Gàidhlig @ Àrd-ìre).

Tha obair a' chùrsa seo tro mheadhan na Gàidhlig.

Bidh clasaichean **Sgilean Càinain** gach seachdain a' leasachadh do sgilean sgriobhaidh (gràmar, facail ùra, gnàthsan-cainnt) agus do sgilean labhairt ttro dheasbadan agus taisbeanaidhean).

Ann an clasaichean **litreachais** bidh thu a' sgrùdadadh:

- dràma, nobhailean no sgeulachdan goirid bhon 20mh linn 's bhon latha an-diugh (m.e. Catriona Lexy Chaimbeul, Aonghas Pàdraig Caimbeul).
- òrain Ghàidhlig air cuspairean sònraichte bho linn nan Seumasach (1700an) chun an 20mh linn.



Ann an Semeastair 2 bidh aon òraid Bheurla gach seachdain mun chultar Ghàidhealach tro na linnteann ('Saoghal nan Gàidheal: Gaelic Society & Culture through the ages').

Clasaichean: 4 agus an uair sin 5 gach seachdain.

Obair measaidh: obair càinain (gach coladeug), 2 aiste litreachais, 1 deuchainn-clas, 1 deuchainn sgriobhte agus 1 deuchainn-labhairt.
