We are a team of researchers based at the University of Glasgow, working on the European Research Commission funded project “Democracy under Threat: How Education can Save it” (DEMED).

Together with the Varieties of Democracy (V-Dem) Project (<https://www.v-dem.net/en>) at the University of Gothenburg, we would like to invite you to participate in a new DEMED and V-Dem joint project as a **Country Expert on Education** for the country (or countries) of your expertise.
