Introduction

Ludwig (Lajos) Blau was a Hungarian scholar and rabbi, born April 29, 1861, at Putnok, Hungary.¹ Blau's father, Mór, a tenant farmer, also owned a small grocery, so was sufficiently affluent to provide private tuition for his five sons. Ludwig was subsequently educated at three different yeshivas, at Putnok with Rabbi Jakob Tennenbaum, at Szilágysomlyó (now in Romania) under Rabbi Mordecai Horovitz, followed by two years in Pressburg (now Bratislava), deepening his knowledge of traditional Jewish studies in the famous yeshiva headed, at that time, by Rabbi Simche Bunim Sofer, the 'Shevet Sofer'.² Most of the Jewish chaplains in the Austro-Hungarian Army were graduates of the Pressburg Yeshiva,³ and it would appear that, at some point, Blau joined their ranks (see photograph on page 8).

In 1879 he decided to leave the orthodox environment of the yeshiva and enrol in the recently established Országos Rabbiképző Intézet (National Rabbinical Seminary) in Budapest. Opened in 1877, this was a Neológ institution, providing a secularly educated clergy, promoting a moderately reformed Judaism, and encouraging assimilation into Hungarian society (Magyarization). Blau also studied philosophy and orientalia at the University of Budapest, receiving his doctorate there, cum laude, in 1887, and the rabbinical diploma in 1888.

While still a student in 1887, Blau was invited to be a teacher of the Talmud at the Seminary subsequently becoming, in 1889, professor of the Bible, the Hebrew and Aramaic languages, and Talmud. Additionally, in 1899, he became librarian and tutor in Jewish history. In 1914 Blau became the third director of the Seminary.⁴

For 40 years from 1891 until 1931 he was the editor of the Jewish journal, *Magyar Zsidó Szemle* (Hungarian Jewish Review),⁵ initially with Ferenc Mezey, who conducted a publicity campaign for the recognition of Judaism as a received, or state supported religion. Mezey left the journal in 1896 when this aim was achieved, and under the sole editorship of Blau the periodical became purely scholarly. The journal was recognised as an official organ of the Rabbinical Seminary from 1927 onwards. The Hungarian language employed by the review

tended to isolate Hungarian Jewish studies and obscure the full importance of Blau's scholarly output.

In 1911 he founded the Hebrew journal *Ha-Sofeh me-Eres Hagar* (later *Ha-Sofeh le-Hokhmat Yisrael*) which he edited until 1931. Blau was a prolific scholar who contributed to many aspects of Jewish learning, contributing to most of the Jewish and non-Jewish scholarly journals devoted to theology and philology. His bibliography includes 887 items and in the *Zsidó Szemle* he reviewed 1,383 books. He was pioneering in his evaluation of Talmudic information on the Bible and the masorah (*Masoretische Untersuchungen*, 1891; *Zur Einleitung in die Heilige Schrift*, 1894). He was also amongst the first to consider Greek papyri in the context of halakhah (*Papyri und Talmud in gegenseitiger Beleuchtung*, 1913; 'Prosbul im Lichte der griechischen Papyri und der Rechtsgeschichte', in *Festschrift der Landesrabbinerschule*, 1927). Blau also published the letters of the famous Venetian rabbi, Leon Modena or Yehudah Aryeh mi-Modena (1571–1648) (*Leo Modenas Briefe und Schriftstücke*, 2 vols., 1905–06).

In addition to his academic work, in 1902 Blau became president of the folk-lore section of the Jewish-Hungarian Literary Society. He retired in 1932 and died in 1936.

The whole collection amounted to some 3,000 items, reflecting Blau's principal areas of research and teaching. In 1937 Glasgow University acquired part I of the Hebraica section (Alte Bücher), comprising 198 early printed items, 111 of which have 16th century publication dates. The one incunable mentioned in the printed catalogue was not included in the final purchase.

It seems that the University became aware of the availability of Blau's library through contact with the Rev. George A. F. Knight,⁶ Church of Scotland minister at the Scottish Mission to the Jews in Budapest⁷ from 1935 until 1940. A minute from the Library Committee meeting held on 8th May 1937 headed, 'Proposed purchase of books from the library of the late Professor Blau' reads: 'Professor Stevenson explained that he had been in communication with the Rev. G. F. Knight in Bude Pesth concerning the purchase of the section of books from the library of the late Professor Blau. Mr Knight was in treaty with Frau Dr Blau and hoped to negotiate the purchase of the wanted books for £200'. Professor William Barron Stevenson⁸ (1869-1954) was Professor of Hebrew and Semitic Languages at the University from 1907 to 1937. At a subsequent meeting on 15th October, presumably after the books had been received, 'Professor Stevenson had desired him [i.e. the Librarian] to convey to the Library Committee the expression of his deep regret that so many of the books in the Blau Collection were in such poor condition.'


The descriptions of the collection which follow were made for the Library's main catalogue by the present writer, while employed as a graduate trainee in the Special Collections Department of Glasgow University Library (1975-6). They are arranged in date order, and derive, largely unedited, from the Library's current on-line catalogue. In addition, a more detailed bibliographic description of the twenty oldest imprints is appended.

Our copy lacks the first leaf with the laudatory poem by Judah Leon Abravanel, printed within a decorative frame, and begins at leaf 1/2r. Also wanting, leaves 1/4-5.

Bound with the author's *Zevah pesah* and *Nahalat Avot* (in a different order from Yaari 3). This volume also lacks the special leaf with the printer's colophon mentioned by Yaari, p.61.

Provenance: Ludwig Blau (1861-1936) Hungarian scholar and rabbi.

Binding: Constantinople (?), 16th cent., damaged, with almost half of spine missing; blind-tooled brown goatskin over pasteboards formed of printer's waste (Hebrew: see below), cut flush with the text block; endpapers a coarse laid paper; sewing is stabbed, with five cords; back flat with no bands; evidence remains of two leather clasps, hinged on the upper cover - two metal pegs of the lower clasp are all that have survived at the fore-edge on the lower cover; remains of patches of leather at the head and tail of the spine perhaps intended to strengthen the binding; covers decorated in blind with a central panel formed of seven, six-petalled, circular tools, surrounded by a serrated roll-tool and three fillets; this is framed by a mitred border of fillets and a further three rectangles, formed of separate rolls, the outer and inner both floriated and the middle serrated; spine decoration of lozenges formed by blind fillets; an early 20th cent. paper label, with the number '6' written in a blue printed frame, is pasted on the spine (this corresponds to the number in the Blau printed catalogue of 1936). Only 52 lines of 53 are visible, with some text obscured or lost, from Siman 45:40. Pasted over part of this text is a scrap of paper (the remains of a larger sheet?) with fragments of writing in a highly cursive Sephardic Hebrew script of the 18th/early 19th c.(?). Annotations: On recto of the front fly-leaf there is an unclear pencil inscription in Hebrew, and lower down, '175K/sal'. There is an illegible Hebrew inscription in violet ink at the head of fol. 1/2r.

The later prophets Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and the twelve minor prophets, with the Hebrew text, Targum Jonathan, the commentaries of Rashi, Қimhi, Ibn-Ezra on Isaiah and the Minor Prophets (Ibn Ezra's commentaries were omitted from both the Third and Fourth Rabbinic Bibles), and the Masorah in the margin.

Provenance: Ludwig Blau (1861-1936) Hungarian scholar and rabbi.

Binding: Scottish, quarter bound brown goatskin and buckram over pasteboards, mid-20th cent. Apparently not volume three of the Fourth Rabbinic Bible (1568) as indicated on the gold-tooled spine title and date.

Antonius Costantius'. Costanzi has obliterated passages and inserted text in the margins in Ekhah (f.3/7r), Mishle (f.11/7v), Danyel (ff.14/3r and 14/6r). Cf. Ariel Toaff. On f.15/10v there are some faint inscriptions in Italian, a Latin alphabet written in a single column, with some phrases, e.g. 'e sign[o]ra mia cara' 'dona maria', but mostly unclear, and above the latter, in a darker ink, a calculation converting the Hebrew date of the book to the Christian.

On the verso of the rear endpaper is the inscription in Italian, 'a San Giuseppe Capo le Case nella ...'. San Giuseppe a Capo le Case is the church of a former Carmelite monastery in Rome, opened in 1597. Written above this inscription in the same ink is the number '262'. On the same page are several words in an eastern Hebrew script, some of which are glossed with Latin terms, e.g. 'mispar Aritmetica', 'tagboret geometria', 'sifrut retorica', and 'tekhunah Astrologia'.
